LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST

The Maryland Shorthorn Association will host their 23rd Livestock Judging Contest for youth ages 8-18 at the Eastern Regional Shorthorn Show on **Saturday, June 20th** at the Howard County Fairgrounds. MARKET LIVESTOCK WEIGHT CHECK

It is important to monitor the growth rate on your market livestock projects (beef, sheep, goats, swine) especially with the rate-of-gain requirements in effect for the 2008 Fair. The scale will be open at the Howard County Fairgrounds on **Monday, June 29th from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.; Thursday, July 9th from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.; Monday, July 20th from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.** for you to check your animal's weight. A weight check will be canceled if the heat index will be 95 degrees or higher.

2009 MARKET LIVESTOCK RATE-OF-GAIN PROGRAM

Market Livestock (beef steers, market lambs, market pigs, and market goats) must gain a certain amount of weight per day to show in market classes at the 2009 Howard County Fair. Weight gain per day is calculated from weigh-in/tag day to weigh-in at the County Fair. There are several weight check days scheduled at the fairgrounds scale for 4-H'ers to check market animals' weight. Dates are listed in the 4-H calendar.

Beef - 2.0 pounds of gain per day
 Sheep - .40 pounds of gain per day
 Swine - 1.5 pounds of gain per day
 Goat - .20 pounds of gain per day

COMMERCIAL BREEDING SHEEP IDENTIFICATION

Commercial sheep that are **NOT REGISTERED** in a breed association with registration papers must be tagged with a Maryland 4-H Identification Tag. We will be tagging commercial breeding sheep on **Monday, June 29th from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.** at the livestock scale at the Howard County Fairgrounds. Animals should be identified on a Maryland Livestock Registration Form. Bring your form the night of tagging. The Livestock Registration Form is available on-line at www.howard4-h.org under "Forms".

HOWARD COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION, INC. SCHOLARSHIPS



Each year, the Howard County Fair Association, Inc., offers six \$2,000 scholarships to qualified individuals to assist with educational expenses. The scholarships are available to applicants who are or have been active in the Fair, 4-H and/or FFA program in Howard County and who are directing their education toward agriculture, home economics, or a related field. Those applying for a scholarship must be at least a current high school junior. To be considered, applicants must submit a completed application, a current transcript of grades, and supplemental materials supporting 4-H and/or FFA work.

Previous winners of this scholarship are not eligible to reapply. **Applications must be delivered to the Howard County Fair Office, 2210 Fairground Road, West Friendship, Maryland 21794, on or before 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 8th.** Scholarship winners will be announced at the annual Howard County Fair Stockholder's Dinner in October.
