Pre-registration required. PAPER ENTRIES ONLY. Check-in time is 8:30 A.M. Contest begins at 9:30 A.M. All dogs shall be immunized, have a Rabies vaccination and have a Canine Identification Card on file with the 4-H Office prior to May 1st of this year. Rabies vaccination number and date shall be listed on dog registration form at time of county entries. AT ALL TIMES HEALTH PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY CANINE EXHIBIT OR WHILE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.

Dogs are not to leave the show ring area and are to leave the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the show.

1. Dogs of any breed and mixed breeds may participate.
2. Female dogs in season may not compete.
3. Dogs with AKC Obedience titles are ineligible for class in which they have a title.
4. Dogs must be on a leash at all times, except when judging in certain obedience classes.
5. Handlers and dogs must have successfully completed Happy Hounds sponsored obedience and/or Fitting and Showing training classes within the current or previous year prior to entry in the County Fair Canine Show.
6. Multiple members of the same family, or those with a performance animal lease on file, may show the same dog but in different divisions (i.e., Fitting and Showing, Obedience, Agility, Rally).
7. Dogs exhibited must have been trained by the exhibitor.

CLASSES:

(Fitting & Showing: Conformation type of Dog Show Competition designed to demonstrate the ability of the handler to groom and present their dog. Judging is on the basis of the handler's ability to show their dog to it's best advantage, handlers knowledge and skill in care and grooming of the animal - not on the dog's conformation or it's breed)
