

# T - 4-H CLUB BANNER

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**Awards sponsored by:** Howard County 4-H All Stars

1. Each Howard County 4-H Club is eligible to exhibit one banner.
2. Requests for banner space is due to Howard County Extension, 3300 North Ridge Road, Suite 240, Ellicott City, MD 21043, July 1st. (410) 313-2707
3. All banners must be constructed to hang on a rod or pole provided by exhibitor for display purposes. Banner dimensions may be 3 'x4', 2'x6' or 4'x4', all in which are displayed horizontally Banners not meeting these size designations will be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
4. Club names must be used on the banner. Club name, county, club leader name, address, and phone number must be clearly printed on a card and securely attached to the back of the banner in the upper right corner so awards may be mailed to leader.
5. Banners may be constructed of any type of durable material with any type of application, but construction of materials that can be folded or rolled. Applique, embroidery, and trapunto are suggested applications. Design must be on one side of the banner only and should be two dimensional, expressing one idea.
6. Banner idea/theme should be voted upon at a 4-H meeting. Construction should be assumed by majority of club members. Parents and volunteers may assist but not assume total responsibility. Banner should illustrate the phase of work of the 4-H Club.
7. Banners will be judged under the Danish group system of blue-excellent and red-very good.
8. All banners must display the abbreviated Affirmative Action statement in order to be considered for an award or displayed.
9. Banners must be entered between 4:00-8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 4th and Thursday, August 5th. Judging will be done on Friday, August 6th at 7:00 p.m.

EXCELLENT AWARD – 1 <sup>st</sup> Place	10.00
VERY GOOD AWARD – 2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	5.00
