

S - 4-H CLUB BOOTH

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Awards sponsored by: Howard County 4-H Dairy Club

1. Each Howard County 4-H Club is eligible to enter one booth either under Class 1 or Class 2.
2. Request for booth space is due to the Extension Office by July 1st. Booth entries are accepted between 4:00-8:00 on Wednesday, August 3rd and Thursday, August 4th.
3. Exterior booth dimensions must be 47" wide, 36" deep, and 22" high. The back of the booth must be 47" wide x 22" high. The bottom of the booth must be 47" wide x 36" deep. The sides must be in the shape of a right triangle using the following dimensions: 22"x36"x48".
4. All Booth ideas are to be decided and voted upon at a club meeting. The construction and set-up is to be a joint effort by majority of club members. Previous year theme ideas are unacceptable. Leaders and parents are supervisors only! Otherwise disqualification will be awarded.
5. Contents of the booth must not exceed the booth dimensions listed. Items may not be taller than sides of the booth. A roller test consisting of a wooden dowel being rolled smoothly down the open edges will be conducted at time of entry. Booth contents may graze dowel but not be in risk of damage or broken.
6. Booth construction must withstand for 7 days. Mechanical and electrical parts should be designed to run continuously being plugged in and unplugged daily! Items should be securely fastened to prevent loss. Do not use valuable items or food as contents
7. Club name, city/county, leaders name, phone and address must be neatly printed on card and securely fastened on back of booth in upper right corner. Awards will be mailed to organizational leaders.
8. All booths must display the affirmative action statement in order to be displayed and considered for an award.

CLASSES:

1. State Fair Annual Theme booths shall use the following themes for 2011 - "Balancing Tradition with Challenges of Today"
Next years theme - 2012 - "Go Wild with 4-H"
Open Themed booths may feature any theme promoting 4-H.

EXCELLENT AWARD – 1 st Place	20.00
VERY GOOD AWARD – 2 nd Place	15.00

Up to four booths will be selected as Champion Booths on the county level. The top two Champion Booths will go on to State competition. Grand Champion booth will be selected from the top two champion booths. Clover club booths do not receive Champion because they cannot go to State Fair
