RULES AND REGULATIONS

Awards sponsored by: Howard County 4-H Dairy Club

1. Each Howard County 4-H Club is eligible to exhibit one booth. This years theme "The Sky's the Limit".
2. Requests for booth space is due to Howard County Extension, 3300 North Ridge Road, Suite 240, Ellicott City, MD 21043, by July 1st.
3. 4-H'ers are responsible for the construction and setup of their booth and must comply with the following: Exterior booth dimensions must be 47" wide, 36" deep, and 22" high. The back of the booth must be 47" wide x 22" high. The bottom of the booth must be 47" wide x 36" deep. The sides must be in the shape of a right triangle using the following dimensions: 22"x36"x48". Booths must be constructed with triangle on side with front open. Contents of the booth must not exceed the booth dimensions listed. Items in the booth must not be taller than the sides of the booth.
4. Booths must be constructed to stand up for 7 days. Mechanical or electrical parts of the booth should be designed to run continuously. Items in the booth should be securely fastened to prevent loss. Do not use valuable items in the booth. No food item is to be used for the contents of booth. Skirted tables will be provided.
5. **The club name, city, club leaders name, address, and phone number must be clearly printed on a card and securely attached to the back side of the booth in the upper right corner.**
6. All booths must be entered between 4:00-8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 4th and Thursday, August 5th. Judging will be done on Friday, August 6th at 7:00 P.M. All booths will be judged on the Danish System.
7. **All booths are to be the work of and set up by the 4-H members - Leaders are for supervision only. Otherwise they will be disqualified.**
8. Awards will be mailed to the Club Organizational Volunteer Leader.
9. Previously listed booth themes are unacceptable.
10. All booths must display the abbreviated Affirmative Action statement in order to be considered for an award.

CLASSES:

1. Annual Theme booths shall use the following themes for 2010 - "Looking into 4-H"
2. Next years theme - 2011 - "Balancing Tradition with Challenges of Today"
3. Open Themed booths may feature any theme promoting 4-H.

Up to four booths will be selected as Champion Booths on the county level. The top two Champion Booths will go on to State competition. Grand Champion booth will be selected from the top two champion booths. Clover club booths do not receive Champion because they cannot go to State Fair.
