Must be enrolled in Entomology project.

1. Insects must be mounted. Insects of the same order should be grouped together. Specimens should be mounted on standard insect pins. Each specimen should be labeled to show where and when it was caught, name of collector, and common name of the insect. Labels should not be larger than ½ by 1 inch.
2. One or more boxes with pinning bottoms may be used. Boxes should be at least 5"x8" in size and covered with glass or other transparent top.
3. Each year's project must show growth in size.
4. Collections will be judged on:
  - a. Accuracy in naming and grouping by order
  - b. Variety of species
  - c. Neatness in mounting and arrangement
  - d. Neatness in labeling

## CLASSES:

1. Collection - 1<sup>st</sup> year exhibitor. Minimum 25 specimens in three or more orders. (All specimens must be identified to order)
2. Collection - 2nd year exhibitor. Minimum 60 specimens in five or more orders. (All specimens must be identified to order)
3. Collection - 3rd year exhibitor. Minimum 100 specimens in ten or more orders. (All specimens must be identified to order)
4. Collection - 4th year or higher exhibitor. Minimum 150 specimens in fifteen or more orders. (All specimens must be identified to order)
5. Educational Exhibit. This exhibit should be suitable for teaching some aspect of entomology. Include a brief explanation of the collection on a 3"x5" card.
