A Well Dressed Table for Every Meal (must be enrolled in Food project or Home Environment project) 4-H'er must personally set up table setting exhibit. **Limited to 16" x 20"**. Table settings must be original. Entries for a past Howard County Fair may not be used again.

Table setting includes: mat or cloth, napkin, plate, cup and saucer, water glass and individual centerpiece.

Silverware - after judging, must be picked up at the 4-H Indoor Exhibit Building. **Menu is to be included on 3"x5" card.** Menu dictates amount of silver and china to use. Type of meal - breakfast, lunch, dinner, special occasion. Make sure menu suits place setting and is simple.
