Home Environment exhibits must be for the home. **No personal items. No clothing items.** Kits permitted where noted.

### Decorating with Stitchery (judged as the complete item)

1. Afghans – knitted
2. Afghans – crocheted
3. Crocheted article
4. Knitted article
5. Beginner's embroidery (1<sup>st</sup> year entry)
6. Embroidered articles
7. Embroidery – Swedish or Candle-wicking
8. Machine stitch embroidery items
9. Latch hooked articles – original design (must have finished edges)
10. Latch hooked articles – kit (must have finished edges)
11. Quilted Articles – hand made or machine, maximum size 45"x60"
12. Quilted Articles – machine made, maximum size 45"x60"
13. Needlepoint, cloth canvas
14. Needlepoint, plastic canvas
15. Counted cross stitched item (original design)
16. Counted cross stitched item – stitched portion, 5"x7" or smaller (kit)
17. Counted cross stitched item – stitched portion, larger than 5"x7" (kit)
18. Braided item or hand-woven item

### Home Accessories – other than above

19. Stenciled article
20. Scrapbooking – traditional album 5-15 pages (may add on to existing album, bookmark or include note in cover where to start judging).
21. Scrapbooking – digital album 10 page minimum, completed album
22. Scrapbooking – 2 page spread, traditional
23. Scrapbooking – digital page print or poster
24. Padded fabric item
25. Wall hanging (not decorated with stitchery item, no wreaths)
26. Window covering – curtains
27. Window covering – swag
28. Throw pillow – original (no latch hook)
29. Throw pillow – kit or pattern (no latch hook)

31. Item for office
32. Item for family or living room
33. Item for kitchen
34. Item for dining room
35. Item for bathroom

**Table Settings – A Well Dressed Table for Every Meal**

(must be enrolled in Food project or Home Environment project) 4-H'ers must personally set up table setting exhibit. Maximum size 16"x20". Table setting must be original. Entries for previous year Howard County Fair may NOT be used again. Silverware – after judging, must be picked up at 4-H Indoor Exhibit Building.

**Table setting includes: mat or cloth, napkin, plate(s), cup and saucer, water glass and individual centerpiece. Menu is to be included on 3"x5" or 5"x7" card.** Menu dictates amount of silver and china to use. Menu should be appropriate for the place setting.
