Those interested must notify 4-H Office by July 19th.
 2. The costumed animal (rabbits, poultry, dog, large animal, etc.) and the descriptive narration (not the costumed 4-H'er) will be judged. Please enter one of the following categories.
 1. Prettiest
 2. Most Creative
 3. Funniest
 4. The animal that stole the show
 5. Smallest
 6. Best Representing 4-H
 7. Animal with most character
 8. Animal from a Fairy Tale
 3. All animals must meet Fair Health Requirements. **Health papers should be with the 4-H'er at all times.** Dogs are not to leave the show ring area and are to leave the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the show.
 4. A \$5.00 participation premium will be paid to entrants. A trophy will be awarded to winners in each category. Ribbons from first through tenth place will be awarded in each category. Clover exhibitors - participation only - no competition.
 5. Only one entry per participant. Previous year entries are not eligible for competition.
