1. Must be enrolled in Photography project.
2. Exhibitors will be limited to one entry per class, and **NO MORE THAN 8 ENTRIES OVERALL.** The same scene cannot be used for more than one class nor can it be used for both color and black and white entries. (Note: only three photographs may be exhibited at State Fair).
3. Photos must be mounted on mat board using spray adhesive, heat seal or other mounting medium. Entries may be matted if desired, but no double matting. Poster board or Illustrative Board should not be used. Do not cover photos with plastic, etc. **No framed photographs!**
4. Photo minimum size is 5"x7", and maximum size is 11"x14". (Note: Minimum State fair photo entry size is 5"x7").
5. Mat size should correspond to photo size, as follows:

Photo Size	Matt Size
5"x7"	8"x10"
8"x10"	11"x14"
11"x14"	16"x20"
6. The following identifying information, typed on a white 3"x5" card, must be securely attached to the top right **back** of the mat board: (1) Entry class, (2) Title of picture, (3) Date picture taken, (4) Name and type of camera, (5) Kind of film used, if any.
7. The following criteria will be used to judge photography entries:

Composition	40%
Story-telling ability	30%
Photographic quality	20%
Mounting	10%
8. All classes except Class 10 may be of Color, Black and White, or digital exhibits.

## CLASSES:

1. Building
2. Landscape
3. Sea/Marine life
4. People - Individual
5. People - Two or more
6. Farm Life
7. Animal, Bird or Insect
8. Flowers or plants
9. Picture Maryland - a photo that captures the spirit of the state.
10. Black & White Photo
11. Still Life
12. Miscellaneous/Experimental - photos that have merit but do not fit in classes listed above (examples: pinhole camera, photogram, digitally altered, etc).
