

# 4-H POULTRY DEPARTMENT

Monday, August 8th - 4:00 P.M.

1. Only approved 4-H Poultry projects will be accepted.
2. Exhibitors must have owned the birds at least 60 days prior to show.
3. Clovers are not permitted to exhibit in the 4-H Poultry Show, however, are welcome to enter in the Open Class Show.
4. Clipped beaks will be allowed in Classes.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries in any one Lot. Exhibitors are limited to one entry each in Class A & B.
6. Poultry must be entered between 9:00 A.M. and 12:00 NOON on Sunday, August 7th and must be removed Saturday, August 13th after 9:00 P.M. Birds left after 11:00 P.M. on Saturday, are left at Exhibitor's risk. Broilers & Capons must arrive by 3:00 P.M. Thursday, August 11th and will be released at the discretion of superintendent.
7. There will be a \$1.00/bird fee collected when birds are brought on Sunday for entry. The fee will cover shavings and clean-up. The fee will be returned if exhibitor participates in the poultry building clean-up day in October.
8. Plastic waterers and feeders will be provided for all birds.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and shavings. Building will be open daily 9:00 AM - 10:00 P.M. Initial bedding will be supplied.
10. Exhibitors must feed and water their birds at least once a day and wood shavings must be changed daily.
11. Exhibitors who neglect their birds will forfeit their premiums.
12. No clipped wings. Slips in capon classes will be eliminated.
13. **PLEASE NOTE:** UNDER A RULING BY THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, ALL POULTRY MUST BE TESTED FOR PULLORUM-TYPHOID AND AVIAN INFLUENZA BEFORE THEY CAN BE ENTERED FOR EXHIBITION. For information on how to have your birds tested, contact the State Veterinarian, Animal Health Section, Maryland Department of Agriculture. BRING YOUR PULLORUM-TYPHOID AND AVIAN INFLUENZA TESTING CERTIFICATE WITH YOU TO THE SHOW. BIRDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OTHERWISE.
14. The Champion Broiler Pen and Champion Capon must sell in the Livestock Sale. The Reserve Champions are optional. The exhibitor of the champion and reserve broiler and capons sold in the sale will have the cost of the buyer's banner deducted from their sale check. Seller is responsible for getting birds processed and delivered within 30 days.
15. Broilers & Capons judging 4:00 P.M. on Thursday. Champion and Reserve Champion Broiler & Capon must stay. All other Broilers & Capons are released on Thursday and must be out by 10:00 P.M.
16. Waterfowl are due in by 3:00 P.M. Monday.
17. Poultry posters must be educational about poultry and the 4-H program. All posters must be pre-entered by July 1<sup>st</sup>. Posters will be collected on Wednesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> or Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-8:00 p.m. at the 4-H indoor building. After judging posters will be displayed in the poultry building. Rabbit Posters must be 14"x22". Posters may use any medium: water color, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils or collage. They can not be three dimensional. Posters may be either horizontal or vertical. Cartoon figures (such as Snoopy) cannot be used because they are copyrighted. The 4-H member's name, age, address, county and a brief explanation should be written on 3"x5" card and attached. Posters will be displayed until the close of the fair. Posters must include the abbreviated AA statement (University of Maryland Extension programs are open to all citizens without regard to race, color, sex, disability, religion, age or national origin). Only one entry per 4-H member per class. Poster must be the work of the 4-Her.
