1. All rabbit entries will be paper entries due to the 4-H office no later than July 1<sup>st</sup>. There will not be online entries.
2. Rabbits must be cooped-in between 8:00 AM-12:00 Noon on Saturday, August 6th. Superintendents will assign cages.
3. All rabbits, including meat pens, must be permanently earmarked in the left ear prior to the fair. Tattoo must be legible. There will be no tattooing at the fair.
4. Clovers will not be permitted to exhibit their rabbits as part of the 4-H Rabbit Department Show on Tuesday morning of the fair except in showmanship. In addition, clovers can enter a rabbit in the 4-H Small Pet Contest.
5. Each 4-H exhibitor is limited to two animals in each class except 1 entry in meat pen. If entries exceed the space available, the superintendent may limit the number of entries per exhibitor.
6. Exhibits must be picked up between 9:00-10:00 P.M. on Saturday, August 13th. Exhibits left are at the exhibitor's risk.
7. Participants must abide by 4-H and A.R.B.A. rules.
8. Building will be open daily from 9:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
9. **Animals showing symptoms of any contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the show and the fair. The decision of the superintendent is final.**
10. The Champion Meat Pen must sell in the Livestock Sale. The Reserve Champion is optional. The exhibitor of the Champion and Reserve Champion Meat Pen will have the cost of the buyer's banner deducted from their sale check.
11. 4-H'ers and Clovers **MUST TEND TO THEIR ANIMALS TWICE A DAY. Check-in with the superintendent when finished.** 4-H'ers must do the work personally. Clovers may have family assistance. Cages must be cleaned by 10:00 am.
12. Exhibitors who do not care for animals on a daily basis will forfeit premiums. Superintendent's rules apply.
13. All rabbits must be owned by date of fair entry. No leased animals will be accepted.
14. All rabbits entered in the fair must stay at the fair all week unless sent home by superintendent.
15. All rabbits will be charged a \$1.00 entry fee to cover bedding.
16. All rabbits must be a minimum of 8 weeks old and weaned.
17. No locks on cages. 1 Rabbit per cage except for Meat Pens.
18. All posters must be pre-entered by July 1<sup>st</sup>. Posters will be collected on Wednesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> or Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-8:00 p.m. at the 4-H Indoor Building. Rabbit Posters must be 14"x22". They MUST address Rabbits and 4-H promotion. Posters may use any medium: water color, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils or collage. They can not be three dimensional. Posters may be either horizontal or vertical. Cartoon figures (such as Snoopy) cannot be used because they are copyrighted. The 4-H member's name, age, address, county and a brief explanation should be written on 3"x5" card and attached. Posters will be displayed until the close of the fair. Posters must include the abbreviated AA statement (University of Maryland Extension programs are open to all citizens without regard to race, color, sex, disability, religion, age or national origin). Only one entry per 4-H member per class. Poster must be the work of the 4-Her.
19. **4-H'ers are responsible for putting coop number in the rabbit's right ear on Monday evening after care of rabbit. Superintendent will be glad to assist you. Rabbits without coop numbers will not be shown.**
20. Champion Showman is ineligible to compete except in a Showman Sweepstakes class in future years.
21. Maryland self certifications for rabbits health is required at check-in.
