1. Entries in this Class will be open to any Howard County 4-H club member. Participant need not be enrolled in the sheep project.
2. Sheep must be a Registered Breeding Ewe or a Market Lamb, fitted and trained to show at halter. Participant does not have to own the sheep.
3. Two divisions will be offered: Division One - Made & Owned; Division Two Bought or Borrowed. Participant may enter in one division only.
4. Sheep may be a registered breeding ewe, ram or market lamb, fitted and trained to show at halter. Superintendent will help make arrangements for borrowed sheep.
5. Entries will be judged on the following: Division One - Made & Owned: Garment must be constructed by contestant, garment is complimentary to contestant, garment construction, entrants poise and appearance, presentation and appearance of animal, control of animal being shown and narration. Garment must be at least 60% wool. Division Two - Bought or Borrowed: Garment is complimentary to contestant, entrants poise and appearance, style and accessories, narration. The outfit is not made by the contestant. Garment must be at least 60% wool.
6. Narration should be between 200 and 500 words typed, double spaced, and include: 4-H club, 4-H projects carried, hobbies, description of garment, percentage of wool. It should be informative, educational and of interest to the spectators. Narration's are to be turned in to the superintendent by Monday, August 10th, 5:00 p.m.
7. Trophies, ribbons, and premiums will be provided in each age category. Clovers will receive a participation ribbon.
